Directions to Campground

190 Maranatha Blvd.
Blowing Rock, NC 28605

From I-81 (North): Go toward Tennessee border to Exit 29 (Damascus Exit) and take Rt. 91 South through Damascus to Mountain City. In Mountain City take US 421 South to Boone, NC (US 321 will join US 421 about 6 miles out of Boone). Take US 321 South toward Blowing Rock, NC.

From the South: Take I-40 West to Hickory, NC. Take US 321 North to Blowing Rock, NC.

From I-81 to I-77 South: Take I-77 South to US 421 West toward Boone, NC. At Boone, take 321 South to Blowing Rock, NC.

From Blowing Rock to Appalachian Advent Christian Campground: Take Business US 321 into the town of Blowing Rock. Turn at US 221. Follow this route approx. 7 miles out of town (many curves). The campground will be on the right.
